French

In French, we will be continuing to learn about French schools and thinking about the comparison between French and English schools. We will be discussing what we like and dislike and giving reasons for our opinions. We will end the topic by translating sentences about French schools into English.

Science

During this term we will be continuing to explore living things. We will be developing our understanding of making new plants, including furthering our understanding of bulbs, corms, seeds and rhizomes. We will also be focussing our attention of the life cycle of mammal.

PE

This term we will be working on developing our swimming strokes effectively. We will also be practising our athletic skills with Mr Small from Synergy. We will work on improving our throwing skills in javelin and increasing our distances in long and triple jump.

Art

We will be developing our painting skills and learning about the skilled artist Paul Klee.

English

In our English narrative, we will be *finally* be using Alma as our narrative stimulus. This fantastic animation will provide opportunities for us to put all of our Year 5 writing skills to good use.

Our Guided Reading text moves on to 'The Longest Night' where we continue to look at the Knights of the Round Table, this time, paying particular attention to the Legend of Sir Gareth.

History

We will be learning all about the Normans and the impact they had upon Britain, and in particular, Lincoln. We will also further develop our knowledge of the Normans during our trip to Lincoln Castle, paying particular attention to William the Conqueror and the effect he had on Lincoln.



Trips and Visits

This term we have an excellent trip to Lincoln Castle, where we will learn all about the Norman history of Lincoln. This trip focuses on what amazing Norman history we have on our doorstep. We will learn about William the Conqueror and what makes Lincoln Castle is so unusual.

Maths

This term we will move on to developing our geometry skills where we will be building upon prior knowledge to reason about the lengths and angles of quadrilaterals. Further on in the term we will be using mathematical equipment to measure angles to check calculations and to discuss the properties of shapes and angles that we are to explore.

The second part of the term focusses on measure – we will be converting units from metric to imperial and vice versa, before applying these conversions to units of mass, length, capacity and time. We will then be thinking about volume and capacity as we near the end of term. In this unit, we will compare and estimate volume and capacity.

ICT

In computing, we will be using Roomle to develop our design skills. We will be creating rooms that include windows and doors and decorate them with furniture and artwork.
